

Election held March 4, 2003
Proposition B. Advisory Measure

Concerning use of 2% TOT for
the Community Center Project

Attached is Resolution Number 2084-03 along with the Napa County Statement of Votes Cast (Page 4 of 6), holding that the results of the election held on March 4, 2003, have been canvassed by Mr. John Tuteur, Napa County Registrar of Voters, and accepted and approved by the Town of Yountville on March 18, 2003.

Proposition B. proposed that 2% of the 12% Transient Occupancy Tax rate be used for the Community Center Project.

Election Results.

Proposition B received 813-Yes, and 389-No votes.
In total, 67.6% voted affirmatively, and 32.4% voted negatively.

Resolution Number 2084-03

Reciting the Fact of the General Municipal Election Held on March 4, 2003 and Declaring the Result and Such Other Matters as Provided by Law

Recitals

- A. A General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the Town of Yountville, State of California, on Tuesday, March 4, 2003, as required by law.
- B. Notice of the election was given in time, form, and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities.
- C. Pursuant to Resolution Number 2027-02 adopted October 15, 2002, the County Election Department canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to this Town Council, the results are received, attached and made a part hereof as "Exhibit A".

Now, Therefore, the Town Council of the Town of Yountville, California, does resolve, declare, determine and order as follows

1. The persons voted for at the elections to fill the offices of:

Mayor, two-year term were:

Todd R. Carlson	709 votes
Eric E. Knight	550 votes

2. Council Members, four year term were:

Donna M. Steiger	774 votes
William "Bill" Dutton	628 votes
Christopher G. Blum	539 votes

3. That the Propositions voted upon at the election are as follows:

"Proposition B / Advisory Measure" ADVISORY VOTE ONLY. THIS PROPOSITION DOES NOT INCREASE TAXES. If Proposition C is approved and the Town's Transient Occupancy Tax (Hotel Tax) is increased from 10% to 12%, should the additional revenue be used for the Town's Community Center Project?

Yes Votes = 813 No Votes = 389

“Proposition C” Shall an ordinance be adopted to increase the Town’s Transient Occupancy Tax (Hotel Tax) from 10% to 12%?”

Yes Votes = 833 No Votes = 390

“Proposition D” “Shall the appropriations limit set pursuant to Article 13B of the California Constitution be raised by the sum of \$900,000 so that the Town of Yountville can expend up to \$900,000 additional funds each year for a four year period commencing with the fiscal year 2003/04? The additional funds to be expended are funds collected through taxes presently in effect and no present tax rates are to be increased.”

Yes Votes = 922 No Votes = 271

4. The number of votes given at each precinct to each person as certified by the County Clerk on “Statement of the Vote Cast,” March 4, 2003, is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit “A;”
5. Todd R. Carlson has received a plurality of votes cast for the office of Mayor, two-year term.
6. Donna M. Steiger and William “Bill” Dutton have received a plurality of votes cast for the offices of Council Member, four-year terms.
7. That Proposition B received a plurality of yes votes and is declared passed as approved by the voters.
8. That Proposition C received a plurality of yes votes and is declared passed as approved by the voters.
9. That Proposition D received a plurality of yes votes and is declared passed as approved by the voters.
10. The Town Clerk shall enter on the records of the Town Council of the Town, a statement of the result of the election, showing:
 - (1) The whole number of votes cast in the Town;
 - (2) The names of the persons voted for;
 - (3) The propositions voted upon;
 - (4) For what office each person was voted for;
 - (5) The number of votes given at each precinct to each person, and for and against each of the propositions;
 - (6) The total number of votes given to each person, and for and against each proposition.
11. That the Town Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the Town Clerk and authenticated; that the Town Clerk shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the office of the Town Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

12. That the Town Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

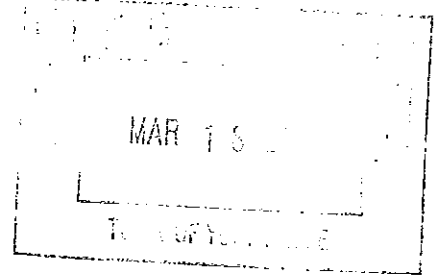
