NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a General Municipal Election will be held in the Town of Yountville on Tuesday, November 2, 2010, for the following Officers and Measure:

- One (1) Mayor Full Term of Four Years
- Two (2) Members of the Town Council Full Terms of Four Years
- One (1) Ballot Measure – Measure P

Measure P (Increase of Appropriation Limits – Gann Limit)

<p>“In order to maintain and preserve vital public services, street maintenance and police and fire emergency medical service programs, shall the appropriations limit set pursuant to Article 13B of the California Constitution be increased by the amount of \$900,000 in additional funds each year for a four year period commencing with fiscal year 2010/11? By approving this appropriation limit, no new taxes will be created nor will any existing tax be increased.”</p>	Yes

If nomination papers for an incumbent officer of the Town are not filed by August 6, 2010, the voters shall have until August 11, 2010, to nominate candidates other than the person(s) who are the incumbents.

If no one or only one person is nominated for each office, the Town Council may appoint someone to the office(s).
