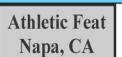

## STREET REPAVING

On Monday, September 24, 2012, J. A. Gonsalves and Son Construction is scheduled to begin a Capital Improvement Project to resurface portions of the following streets: Washington Street south of California Drive, Mulberry Street east of Washington Street to Ivy Court, Finnell Road between the Bardessono Hotel and Hopper Creek and Vista Drive south of Finnell Road. In addition, a new ADA accessible pedestrian ramp will be constructed at the intersection of Vista Drive at Finnell Road. The contractor will provide notification of the street closures and parking restrictions in advance of the work. The project should be completed by mid-October 2012, weather permitting. There will be temporary parking and travel lane disruptions along these streets during construction. Motorists are advised to follow the signage and temporary detours. People who park on these streets will need to find another place to park at during the construction. Additional information on alternative parking locations will be provided.
