RENOVATIONS TO THE HISTORIC TOWN HALL TO BEGIN IN JUNE

If you have entered Yountville Town Hall recently you have probably noticed the bright posting at the entryway that proclaims "EARTHQUAKE WARNING – This is an unreinforced masonry building. You may not be safe inside or near unreinforced masonry buildings during an earthquake." The Town Council has recently secured funding to move forward with structural strengthening of Town Hall to make it a safe place for the public and employees which work there. Yountville Town Hall was originally built in 1930 as a three room elementary school and served as a school until 1977 when the school was moved next door because the building did not meet code requirements for a school. The Town Council considered renovation versus new construction and ultimately opted to restore the building reflecting on its historical significance to the community. The Town Council has approved a budget of \$3.2 million for the project which will start construction in June after completion of the elementary school year. The renovation work will have a significant impact on Town Hall operations and our employees who work out of it. Because there is no vacant office space in Yountville, the Town will be relocating staff to modular trailer units placed on the front lawn. 


HOW TO FIND OUT MORE AND APPLY


ONLINE REGISTRATION FOR PARKS & RECREATION
