Yountville Underpass Mural Dedication: We Did It!

In late June, the Town formally dedicated "Memory of a Tree". The mural was selected through a public process established by the Yountville Town Council and Arts Commission to be installed as a mural covering the abutments of the Highway 29 underpass and California Drive. Sofia Lacin and Hennessy Christopel of LC Studio Tutto were the artists commissioned to design the mural. The imagery demonstrates "how many of us are rooted to this land through generations".
