Envision Yountville Speaker Series Dates

The next several months will be exciting ones for the Town of Yountville. Beginning on February 16, 2017 the Yountville Community Center will house five engaging community events that are all about what makes Yountville "Yountville". This five-part speaker series will include special guest speakers from our region as well as nationally respected planning experts who will discuss important topics related to community character.

All sessions begin at 6:00 p.m. at the Community Center



The dates and topics are detailed below:

February 16 – Overview of Envision Yountville

This speaker session will feature a group of local planning experts that will discuss the past, present, and future of Yountville.

March 9 – Mobility

This session includes local representatives of several transportation authorities and coalitions and will focus on how we all get around the community.

March 23 – Achieving Balance: Residents and Business

The central theme of this session is the relationship between Yountville's residents and its world renowned businesses.

April 13 – Agricultural Preservation and our Future

The vineyards around Yountville are one of its most beautiful characteristics. This session will focus on the Town's relationship with the agricultural lands around it.

May 18 – Community Character

Join renowned speaker and author of "For the Love of Cities" Peter Kageyama in the final session featuring a general discussion on what gives a community its character.
