Introducing the Newly Renovated Veterans Memorial Park!

Have you checked out Veterans Memorial Park recently? You will notice that it has recently undergone some amazing renovations. This park pays homage to the rich history of veterans and our unique relationship with the California Veterans Home in Yountville. You will notice certain notable elements including extra flagpoles to display the MIA flag, service medallions and a special star in the center of the park that represents those who have served or are serving the country. The Town consulted with the California Department of Veterans Affairs and held meetings at the Veterans Home to ensure these elements were accurate and inclusive.



This park also features a grassy amphitheater, which residents can enjoy during the music in the parks series. It is the perfect spot to enjoy some shade or sun, and catch up with your neighbors! Brightly colored flowers add different levels of landscape, offering a refreshing look all year round!



The design of the park was made possible from community input through the Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission and the Town Council. Their guidance allowed Town staff to create a vibrant new park.
