

A Reminder About Town Parks!

One of the most common things we hear from residents and visitors is how beautiful our parks are. Your Town Staff takes great pride in making sure that our parks, paths and shared spaces are beautiful, safe and well maintained. You can help us make sure EVERYONE enjoys our parks by remembering to follow these park rules! For a comprehensive list of park rules and regulations visit www.townofyountville.com/parks:

1. Dogs are never allowed in the children's playground area of any of our parks.
2. Well behaved, on leash dogs (leash length of 10 feet or less) are welcome in all other areas of our parks as long as dog excrement is picked up immediately.
3. Amplified Music is only allowed in parks by permit.
4. Smoking is NOT allowed in any of our parks or recreation areas. This includes the use of tobacco products and marijuana as well as electronic "Vape" devices.
5. Jumpy Houses or other inflatable structures are not permitted in parks.
6. Our parks are open sunrise to sunset unless permitted for a special event.
7. Park Picnic sites can be reserved for your event. Call 944-8712 to learn more.
8. "Commercial Use" of parks is only allowed by permit. For example, Bike Tour or Segway Tour Companies must have a permit.



If you have a concern about someone not following a park regulation, please call the Sheriff's Department non-emergency number at (707) 253 – 4451 or in the event of an emergency, call 911. If you have a question or concern about a park please feel free to contact the Parks and Recreation Department at (707) 944-8712 or Town Hall at (707) 944-8851.
