Did You Know You Can Now Manage Your Water Usage?

Have you ever wanted to manage your own water usage, and see how much water you are using? The Town of Yountville is excited to offer the "Eye on Water" App. Signing up is easy - just visit <https://eyeonwater.com/signup>. Enter your account number on your water bill (Do not use dashes or spaces). Enter and confirm your email address, and create your password.




The App will show you Hourly, Daily, and Monthly usage graphs, and week to week comparisons. Residents can also receive leak alerts by setting custom usage thresholds.

Daylight Savings ends on November 5th at 2:00 a.m.

Don't forget to turn your clocks back an hour!

This is also the time to check your home's smoke and carbon monoxide detectors. It is recommended that you give them a dusting, replace the batteries and run a test to make sure they are operating properly.
