Resident Utility Low-Income Subsidy Program

The Town of Yountville's Utility Low-Income Subsidy Program will start on July 1, 2018. To be eligible for this subsidy, customers must meet the following criteria:

- Be enrolled in the PG&E California Alternate Rates for Gas and Electric (CARE) program.
- Must have a Town of Yountville utility account.
- Must provide a copy of their PG&E bill that shows the account is registered in the CARE program for the same property address as the Town utility service address.
- Must annually renew their eligibility for the Town Low-Income Subsidy Program.
- Eligible accounts will receive a monthly reduction of \$25 off of their fixed fee charges.
