Both shows start at 5:00 p.m. and a food truck will be available on-site.



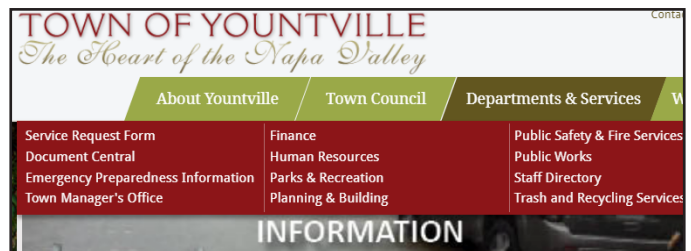
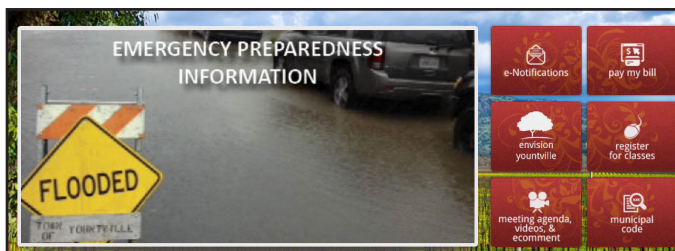

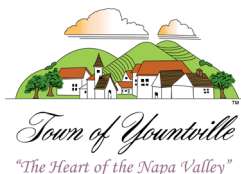
New Date for 2019 Yountville Days Parade & Festival!
