
Emergency Preparedness Open House

The Emergency Preparedness Ad Hoc Committee hosted its second annual Emergency Preparedness Workshop on November 18, 2019. The workshop focused on the new initiative Neighbors Helping Neighbors.

The Emergency Preparedness Ad Hoc Committee introduced the Neighbors Helping Neighbors initiative with the goal of residents creating their own neighbor as a tool to prepare for up to 72-hours without communication or assistance after a disaster strikes. The Emergency Preparedness Ad Hoc Committee also provided checklists and sign-up sheets to those in attendance to help them start their own Neighbors Helping Neighbors group. They also announced a contest which will give the best prepared Neighbors Helping Neighbors group a "Most Prepared Neighborhood" trophy and a BBQ party for the group.

Town Manager Rogers also shared the new local evacuation route maps. These maps will help residents understand which route to take in an evacuation situation since the direction can vary based on the event.

Is Your Dog on a Leash?

The Town reminds residents and guests that, per Town's Municipal Code (Ordinance 6.04.060), all dogs need to be on a leash of 10 feet or less in length and under control of a responsible person while in parks and public areas. Not leashing a dog could result in receiving a citation. Also, please use the provided Mutt Bags in Town and pick up after your dog.

If you would like to let your dog roam without a leash, you can take them to Alston Park, located at 2037 Dry Creek Road in the City of Napa. If you want to report an unleashed animal in Town, please contact the Sheriff's Office non-emergency number at (707) 253-4451.
