## Regarding Rental Properties

Yountville properties owners often ask what is and is not permitted when it comes to renting out their properties in Yountville. Here are a few helpful hints for renting your property:

**IT IS PERMISSIBLE** to rent your home for over 30 days to someone as a residence. Simply obtain a Residential Rental Permit (available at [www.townofyountville.com](http://www.townofyountville.com)) and include your rental permit number on your advertisements!

**IT IS NOT PERMISSIBLE** to rent your home as a vacation rental for less than 30 days. Vacation stays (for a week or a weekend or any period of time less than 30 days) in Yountville are not permitted to protect the quality of life in our residential neighborhoods.

**IT IS PERMITTED** to use any advertising platform you wish to advertise your rental property—Zillow, VRBO, Airbnb, Craigslist, HomeAway, newspaper ads, etc.—the Town places no limit on the number of platforms you may choose to use to advertise, but you do need to include your permit number.


## July Free Movie and Music in the Park
