### Town Projects Update

You may have noticed a number of construction work taking place throughout the Town in the last few months. Most of the construction has been part of the Public Works Department Capital Improvement Project which forecasts and plans for improvements that keep the town looking beautiful and providing a high level of service. Here are some of the projects that have concluded and one that will begin shortly:

**The Yount Street Paving** – This project, completed in May, and paid by Measure T and SB1 state funds, involved the process of reconstruction and repaving of Yount Street between Washington Street and Mount Street after the Town replaced waterlines.

**Town Trees Improvements** – The Town did tree trimming and tree planting in Vineyard Park and Yountville Community Park as recommended by Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission and approved by the Town Council. This project was necessary to support the trees health and provide a safe park environment for residents and visitors.

**Webber Street Pressure Reducing Valve Replacement (PRV)** – The Town completed the replacement of Webber Street's PRV, which will help reduce or even eliminate low water pressure when the Town needs to switch to the Napa County water system.

**Waterline Replacements** – The Town will begin exploratory studies on the condition of the waterlines in the Washington Park neighborhood areas. The Town Council included funding in the Water Utility Enterprise Fund for this study due to the significant number of mainline breaks which are occurring well before the 50-year life cycle of a properly installed waterline.



### Envision Yountville General Plan Approved

On May 7, 2019, The Town Council, with support of the Zoning and Design Review Board and residents of Yountville, celebrated the approval of the Town's new General Plan.

The plan provides a comprehensive range of townwide policies and goals to help define the values and plans for the future needs of the Town.
