The person calls an elderly person and claims to be a family member in trouble or in need of money. The caller typically asks the victim to get gift cards or to send money electronically. The caller will try to keep the victim on the phone.

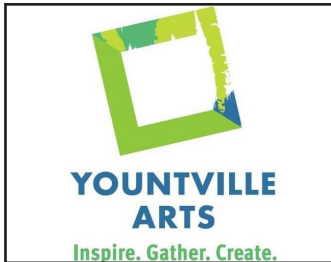

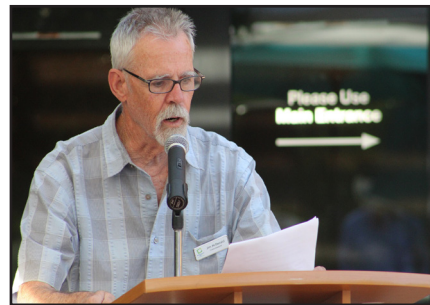
