Sign Up for AutoPay



Are you tired of having to call or walk to Town Hall to pay your utility bill every month? Then you should sign up for Autopay! Visit our website at www.townofyountville.com and click the "Pay My Bill" icon. That will open a new page where you need to click "First Time User? Register Now!" to create your account.

Once you are registered, login and click "My Profile" tab at the top of the page and add a credit card you would like to automatically charge to pay your monthly bill. Make sure to check the Autopay box under the "Options" heading before hitting the "Add Payment Method" button. Once done, paying your bill will be fast, easy, safe, paid!

Keeping Yountville Beautiful

Town Hall has been receiving numerous complaints from residents regarding pet waste not being picked up by their owners in Town. Town staff would like to remind residents and visitors that it is town policy that people clean after their pets. It may seem harmless and that it will biodegrade naturally, but pet waste contains worms, pathogens, parasites and bacteria that harm the environment different from wildlife. And when it rains, this waste can end up in our rivers causing potentially more harm.

The Town has created a Mutt Mitt Waste Station program that provides eco-friendly waste bags for pet owners to clean waste left by pets. They are easily accessible throughout Town. The easiest way to find a Mutt Mitt Waste Station is by downloading the MYville app. Not only will it give you maps to locate the nearest Mutt Mitt Waste Station but many other functions as well. You can download the MYville app free from your phone's app store.



Peddlers and Solicitors Permit

The Planning and Building Department has implemented a new Peddlers and Solicitors Permit application available on the Town's website. All persons interested in selling goods, wares merchandise, or services at a public place within Yountville need to submit an application. All peddlers must have Town issued permits with them.
