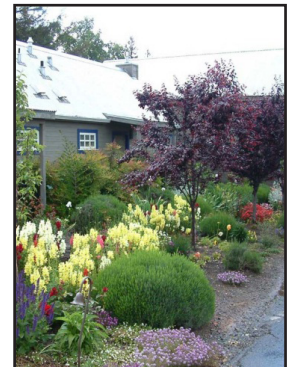
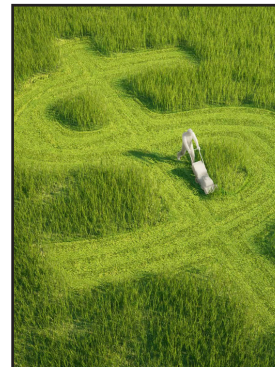


GET CASH FOR GRASS

HOPPER CREEK PATH COMPLETED

On July 7, 2020, the Town Council approved the Notice of Completion for the Hopper Creek path reconstruction which repaired segments of the path between Hopper Creek Condos to Yount Street. The project replaced the existing aged asphalt surface with a more durable concrete surface. The new path uses the same color and style as the segment that was replaced previously from Hopper Creek Condos to Finnell Road.
