The Town of Yountville would like to congratulate Margie Mohler and Eric Knight for being elected as Councilmembers in the November 3, 2020 General Elections. This year, the Town had four residents running for two Council seats. Margie Mohler and Eric Knight received the top two highest number of votes and will serve a term expiring on 2024.

We want to also thank Jeffrey Durham and Scott Owens for participating in the process and wanting to serve our beautiful community. The Town also recognized Councilmember Durham at the November 17 Town Council meeting for his six and a half year of service to the Town. Councilmember Durham's service has left a significant impact in Town through his participation in multiple projects such as the Envision Yountville General Plan update, the Housing Element update, the approval of the first food truck permit, renovation of Yountville Veterans Memorial Park, the establishment of timed parking in commercial areas of Town, and much more.

- One (1) Yountville Community Foundation Board



## Winter Storm Season Preparation

The winter storm season is in full swing and the Town would like to remind Yountville residents to take the necessary precautions. Winter storms can bring a significant amount of rain that can lead to localized flooding and make the roads dangerous. The Town, in partnership with Napa County, will open the sandbag station once a major storm is announced to hit town. The station will be located near the northwest corner of Washington Street and Grant Street at Yountville Community Park. Sandbags will be provided and can be found in a bin, but we ask residents to bring their own shovels to fill the bags.
