
Happy 2020 Yountville!

On behalf of the Town of Yountville, we wish you a Happy 2020! And to start the year strong, the Parks and Recreation Department has released the Winter 2020 Guide! The Guide is a great source to find out about all the exciting free, or at a low cost, programs that the Town has for you. Here are some highlights of fun early in 2020:

BRIDGE: Come to Yountville Community Center on Wednesdays to play BRIDGE! This cool game led by locals Billie Hewitt and Karla Yates is a favorite of locals. The first meet is on Wednesday, January 8, 2020 and continues weekly on Wednesday so you can play and enjoy each others company. Plus, on Wednesdays, there's always FREE popcorn! This activity is free for all and starts at 1:30 p.m. at Yountville Community Center.

EXCURSION: Join Parks and Recreation for the Legion of Honor Museum Excursion! This excursion takes you through San Francisco to see the work of James Tissot, one of the most celebrated artists of his time. Also on display is Curious & Wonderful Selections from the Achenbach Vault and Alexandre Singh: A Gothic Tale. 

New 3-Hour Parking Limits

The Town has started enforcing 3-Hour parking limits in public parking spots throughout several commercial areas in Yountville. The new parking limits were established after receiving community input and Town Council direction during the Parking Workshops this year. The parking limits are located at the following locations:

- 3-Hour Parking at Washington Street in North Yountville between Pedroni Street and Madison Avenue
- 3-Hour Parking at South of Veterans Memorial Park between California Drive and Champagne Drive
- 3-Hour Parking on Jackson Street along Yountville Community Park at the playgrounds on the south side of the parking area




New Vacancies for Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission
