



YOUNTVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE GETS NEW HELP

The Yountville's Sheriff Office now has eyes in the sky! The Napa County Sheriff's Office recently purchased drones to help officers in crime scene analysis, disaster response, search and rescue, or active incidents. In Yountville, Deputy Carrillo is one of the few officers in Napa to be trained and certified to fly these drones which is no easy task. Deputy Carrillo had to go through pilot school and pass the Federal Aviation Administration pilot test.

The drone assigned to Deputy Carrillo has been affectionally named Little Jorge. It can fly up to 400 feet in the sky and has helped with reported missing persons and looking for suspects involved in burglaries.

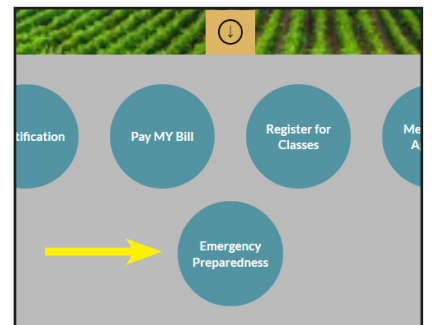
If you see Little Jorge around, he is not spying on you. The Sheriff's Office is required to obtain a warrant to do any surveillance just like any other enforcement agency. Also, any video footage taken by the drone is deleted if it does not pertain to the task the drone has been called to do. So if you see Little Jorge in the Yountville skies remember, he is here to help our Law Enforcement team provide a safer environment and to protect and serve all the Yountville Community.

WASHINGTON PARK EMERGENCY WATERLINE REPLACEMENT

The Public Works Department starts the Washington Park Emergency Waterline Replacement and Paving Projects in mid-September. This project involves replacement of the failing underground water lines placed when the streets subdivision was built in the 1990's. It is anticipated that this emergency repair project will be completed by the end of November.

The map on the right highlights all the areas that will be affected. The Town will provide traffic control while construction is taking place.

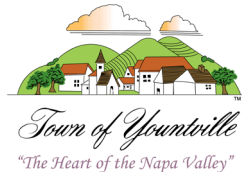
SIGN UP FOR AUTOPAY!
