



## Back-In Angle Parking Coming to Town

The Town of Yountville will soon have improved street parking along Washington Street, north of Madison Street, along the west side of Yountville Community Park. In addition to providing off-street parking, the new configuration of "Back-in Angle Parking" will offer improved safety for drivers, as well as pedestrians and cyclists.

### What is Back-In Angle Parking?

Simple, just like parallel parking:

1. Signal right to indicate your intent to park.
2. Pull forward, past the parking stall and stop.
3. Reverse into the angled parking stall.



### What are the benefits of Back-In Angle Parking?

Back-in angle parking has multiple safety and operational benefits for all road users, such as:

- Improved visibility and increased field of vision. When leaving the parking space, motorists are able to see oncoming traffic.
- Decreased number of collisions. Motorists no longer have to back out blindly from their parking space.
- Improved safety:
  - For children. Car doors open in a manner that directs children to the back of the vehicle, ushering them away from the travelled way.
  - For cyclists. As vehicles exit their parking stall, they are able to see cyclists in the roadway.
  - Improved loading and unloading. Trunks are adjacent to the sidewalk and open car doors offer protection from the street, allowing loading and unloading to occur outside of the traveled roadway.
- Increased space. Reverse angle parking is more efficient leaving space for sidewalks, bike lanes, etc.
- Traffic calming. Adjacent to Community Park we want to encourage the slow speed of vehicles as they travel north on Washington Street.
