Sheriff's Office New Bicycle Equipment

The Yountville Sheriff's Office has new electric-assisted bicycles! With this new equipment, the Sheriffs are now able to enhance their patrol efforts in the community. They will be patrolling parks & paths around Yountville. Other Napa County jurisdictions have had Bicycle Patrol Units and data has shown it to be an effective way to increase officer visibility. The bicycles also serve as a quiet operation that provides a tactical approach to violations in progress. These bicycles can reach speeds of up to 28 miles per hour, which will make it difficult for any burglar to run away! Say "Hi!" next time you see our deputies riding through town on their bikes. They are likely to greet you with a head nod and a smile to keep their hands on the handlebars.

Online Permitting Coming Soon



Applying for a building permit is about to get a whole lot easier!

Soon, Yountville's Planning Department will be launching iWorQ – an online permit processing system. This means that residents will be able to apply for building permits online from the comfort of their own home.

This system will be launching in early 2021 and will help the Town streamline permit applications and accommodate ongoing physical distancing measures. Stay tuned!

Leaf Blower Ban & Subsidy Program

Yountville's Town Council passed ordinance 20-498 which bans gas-powered leaf blowers in Town. The ordinance goes into effect on July 1, 2021 meaning anyone in Town requesting services or wanting to clean leaves from their home must use an electric or battery-operated leaf blower. This ordinance was initiated in response to multiple requests from local residents asking to ban gas-powered leaf blowers due to the excessive noise and environmental concerns they create.

The Council also responded to requests from businesses providing leaf-blowing service regarding the cost of replacing their current equipment. The Town will be offering an equipment replacement subsidy program before the ordinance becomes effective that will assist landscapers serving customers in Town and homeowners replacing their gas-powered leaf blowers with a compliant battery or electric-based leaf blower. To qualify for the program, a business must have a Town of Yountville business license and residents must have an active utility account with the Town. More information to come on the program in the coming months.
