## Emergency Drought Regulations

The Town of Yountville has implemented new irrigation rules for Town water customers based on State mandated water conservation directives. These measures will help the Town through the drought period being experienced in the State due to lack of rain. Please follow these rules to avoid being fined:

- Irrigation is prohibited during rain and within 48 hours of measurable rainfall.
- Irrigation is prohibited between the hours of 10:00 AM and 6:00 PM daily. Yard irrigation is restricted to twice a week per parcel.
  - Even addresses are allowed to irrigate on Mondays and Thursdays.
  - Odd addresses are allowed to irrigate on Tuesdays and Fridays.
- Irrigation of lawns should not cause excess runoff. The Town recommends irrigating at 5-minute increments with 4 hours of separation between each irrigation.

No irrigation is allowed between the hours of 10 A.M. and 6:00 P.M. daily

Yard irrigation is restricted to twice a week per parcel.

On Mondays and Thursdays **even number addresses** are allowed to use water for irrigation.

On Tuesdays and Fridays **odd number addresses** are allowed to use water for irrigation.


