Leaf Blower Ban Starts in July

The Town would like to remind the community that the Council passed Ordinance 20-498 which bans the use of gas-powered leaf blowers in Town starting July 1, 2021. Homeowners or landscapers/gardeners in Town must use an electric or battery-operated leaf blower.

The Town is finalizing outreach efforts to inform landscaping companies of the ban as well as creating an information page on the new incentive program which will help replace the gas-powered equipment. If you currently have a gardener or firm we ask you to please let them know of this coming change and to reach out to Town Hall for further information at (707) 944-8851. The Town offers autopay service for all customers in Town and signing up is super easy. All you have to do is visit our website at www.townofyountville.com and clicking on the Pay My Bill icon on the front page. When you click the icon, you will be taken to our payment page where you can select to log in or register if this is your first time using our page. Once you're registered, all you have to do is go to the My Account section and check the Autopay box under the "Options" heading before hitting the "Add Payment Method" button. HALL HOURS


