Water Conservation Tips

2020 and 2021 have had lack of rain which has put a strain on our water reservoir. Due to the lack of precipitation, the Town is urging all customers to use water wisely this year with conservation efforts. You can make small changes around the home that can make a big difference. To save water now, follow these tips:

- Waiting until the rainy season has fully ended to turn on your automatic irrigation system.
- Consider limiting lawn watering to just one day per week in May, two days per week June and August.
- Applying mulch to planted areas to retain moisture in the soil.
- Running only full loads of laundry or dishes.
- When loading the dishwasher, skip rinsing and scrape food scraps into a compost bin instead of using the garbage disposal.
- Turning off the water while you lather with soap, shave, or brush your teeth.
- Not using the toilet as a trash can. Never flush wipes, tissues, masks, gloves, or paper towels.
