Online Permitting and Licensing Portal now available!

Yountville has a new online portal for residents and businesses to utilize in applying for building permits, business licenses, and other finance needs.

For building permits, requests will be uploaded electronically which will allow town staff, plan checkers, building inspectors, and the applicant access to these documents via the new online portal.

Town Phase II Water Shortage Emergency

In response to single-family residential customers requesting more flexibility with when to irrigate their landscaping, the Town Council adopted different restrictions for single-family residential customers.

The revised rules for single-family residential customers eliminate the 450 gallons per day maximum and the two-day a week irrigation restriction requirement and now allow a simple weekly maximum water allocation of 2,350 gallons of water per week. This will allow each homeowner to manage their water use on a weekly basis. The change is specific to residential customers and those specific items. All of the other water regulations remain in place and the two-day a week irrigation rule still applies to commercial and other water customers.

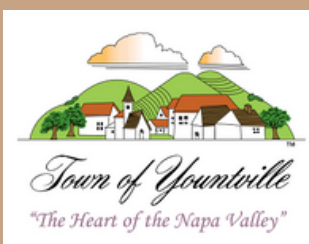
