



IRRIGATION DURING THE RAINY SEASON

Mother nature has arrived to give our irrigation a little break! Since landscape irrigation can make up about half urban water use, turning off irrigation just for even a short period of time can save a considerable amount of water. Before rainfall, be prepared to:

- Turn off/reschedule irrigation systems. Drought regulations are still in effect --irrigation of landscapes with potable water is not permitted during or up to 48 hours of measurable rainfall. Be sure to plan and adjust your irrigation systems accordingly.
- Inspect systems: If you have rain sensors or a weather-based irrigation controller as a part of your irrigation system, make sure that they're functioning properly.
- Stop hand watering: Give the garden hose or the watering can a break while mother nature takes the wheel.
- Unsure what to do? Talk to a pro: Consult your gardener or irrigation/landscape professional if you are unsure about how to adapt your irrigation schedule for the rainfall.



Water Conservation Update

The State of California, including the Town of Yountville, remain in a drought categorized as "**Extreme**". This means that any and all water conservation is needed. As of November 2022, there are 343 residents that have signed up for Beacon Eye on Water. The Town is grateful for those who have signed up and are hopeful that more residents will sign up and use the service to monitor their water use.

Single family residential water customers are limited to a weekly allowance of 2,350 gallons of water per week and make up about 72% of the Town's water customer base which is the Town's largest water customer. The Town would like to thank and acknowledge that 86% of total single family residential customers are complying with the current water restrictions, while only 14% of customers are in violation of excess water use.

The efforts to conserve water now will help us in the future during the extreme drought we are experiencing. By limiting the use of water on non-essential activities such as landscaping irrigation, pressure washing and pool water we are creating a reserve for essential water use like drinking water and house water in the continued drought condition. It is important to note, even if the regions receives normal rainfall totals, it will not be near enough to eliminate the drought.

Town Staff would like to thank *all* water customers, both residential and commercial, for their diligent water conservation efforts and change in water use behavior.
