LIHWAP is a federally funded program that offers low-income households a one-time payment to help pay past due bills for residential water/wastewater costs. In the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic, the federal government awarded California funding to help households struggling to afford the costs of water.



Town Phase II Water Shortage Emergency

On July 19, 2022, Town Council adopted new water restrictions for residential customers to simplify them.

- Residential meters serving one unit shall not exceed 2,350 gallons per week. Meters serving two units 3,655 gallons per week.
- ALL outdoor irrigation is prohibited between the hours of 10AM & 6PM
- No using potable water to wash down structures, sidewalks, and driveways.
- No watering outdoor landscapes in a manner that causes runoff.
- No watering of park medians allowed without a drip irrigation system.
- No irrigation is permitted during or 48 hours after measurable rainfall.
