NEW YEAR, NEW TOWN COUNCIL

The Town of Yountville welcomed a new mayor and two new council members who took the oaths of office during the Town Council Meeting on December 6, 2022. Marjorie "Margie" Mohler previously served as a council member and is now seated as Mayor. Robin McKee-Cant and Hillery Bolt Trippe will serve as council members. The newly elected individuals will all hold office for terms of four years expiring December 2026.

In addition to the newly elected officials, the Town Council includes Vice Mayor Eric Knight previously elected as council member in November 2020 and appointed as vice mayor at the December 6, 2022.

VACANT COUNCIL MEMBER SEAT APPOINTMENT:

The recent election resulted in a vacant seat previously held by Mayor Mohler. After a discussion of options, the council decided to fill this position through an appointment process rather than calling a special election.

To apply for this position a person must:

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Reside in Yountville
- Be a registered voter in Yountville

Application deadline is **January 5, 2023** at 4:00 P.M. No late applications will be accepted.

Utility Rate Assistance Program

The Town Council has increased the Low-Income Resident Utility Rate Assistance Program to \$50 per month starting January 1, 2023. To be eligible, customers must meet the following criteria:

- Be enrolled in the PG&E California Alternate Rates for Gas and Electric (CARE) program: www.pge.com/CARE
- Must provide a copy of the PG&E bill that shows the account is registered in the CARE program for the same name and property address as the Town utility service address.
- Must annually renew their eligibility for the Town Low-Income Subsidy Program.
- Must have an active Town of Yountville utility account in their name.

Eligible accounts will receive a monthly reduction of \$50 off fixed fee charges. If you have any questions, please call Town Hall at (707) 944-8851.

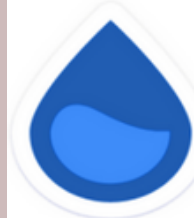
