BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS VACANCIES

Are you interested in helping shape Yountville? Volunteer on one of the Town's boards and commissions! The Town has begun recruitment for the following committees:

Affordable and Workforce Housing Oversight Committee –

The Town of Yountville is seeking two volunteers to serve on the Affordable and Workforce Housing Oversight Committee. This committee reviews the status of programs and services funded with a combination of Measure S funds and funds from other sources or accounts. The vacancies are for the Yountville Business Representative and Yountville Lodge Business Representative. However, any resident of the town is welcome to apply should the vacancies remain vacant. The term of office for both positions commences October 2, 2023 and expires October 1, 2025.

Napa Valley Transportation Authority – Citizen Advisory Committee (NVTACAC) – The Town of Yountville is seeking one volunteer to serve as the Town's representative to NVTACAC. The committee examines issues related to all modes of transportation including automobiles, transit biking, and walking to update transportation infrastructure and improve the health and wellbeing of our community. The term of office commences October 2, 2023 and expires on October 1, 2025.

The deadline to apply for the above positions is Thursday, August 31, 2023 at 5:00 P.M.

Zoning and Design Review Board (ZDRB) – the Town of Yountville is seeking one (1) community volunteer to serve, due to an opening of an unexpired term. The purpose of the ZDRB is to review matters related to planning and development and make recommendations to the Town Council consistent with Yountville's Zoning and Design Ordinances, General Plan and administrative policies. This vacancy has a term beginning immediately upon appointment and expires on July 19, 2025. The deadline to apply for ZDRB is Thursday, August 9, 2023 at 5:00 P.M.
