We are waiting on the weather to begin the refinishing project of the Vineyard Park Tennis Courts. The Contractors need a week of 75° days and no less than 55° nights in order to place the new Titan Trax Material on the courts and have it set and cure properly.

When this project begins, the courts will be closed for a week. We ask the public to please pay special attention to caution tape and closed signs. When the project is finished, the courts will have a crack free, new surface that should last up to 10 years.
