Drought Update

The Town has entered Phase 2 Water Emergency and will continue to take an aggressive approach to reduce water usage and enforce water conservation compliance requirements.

For more information on the Water Conservation Update Presentation given on 05/03/2022 and to learn more details about the Phase 2 Water Shortage Emergency Regulations (Resolution Number 22-4118) please visit:

Current requirements include:

- In no event shall residential users exceed **450 gallons per day**.
- All outdoor irrigation is **prohibited between the hours of 10:00 a.m. & 6:00 p.m.**
- **Even** numbered addresses may irrigate **only on Monday and Thursday.**
- **Odd** numbered addresses may irrigate **only on Tuesday and Friday.**
- No irrigation is permitted on **Saturday, Sunday, and Wednesday.**
- **No hand watering or washing of motor vehicles** with a hose unless the hose is fitted with a shut-off nozzle.
- **No irrigation of parking median strips** (between the sidewalk and the curb) is allowed without a drip irrigation system.


