## DECLARING APRIL 30, 2021 AS NATIONAL "ARBOR DAY"

**WHEREAS**, the State of California recognizes Arbor Day March 7; and

**WHEREAS**, the community continues to place great importance in the planting, care and preservation of trees throughout the Town of Yountville; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Yountville will plant new trees this month.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that I, John F. Dunbar, as Mayor of the Town of Yountville, do hereby proclaim April 30, 2021 as Arbor Day in the Town of Yountville and continue the celebration throughout the month with the planting of trees.
