





Fences and Walls in Yountville

Are you interested in installing or replacing a fence or wall on your property?

Fences, walls, and landscape screening need to conform to a variety of conditions. If you'd like to understand more about what your property's specific allowances and limitations are, please contact a Planner at Town Hall at (707) 944-8851.



Height Requirements

- Fences along a rear or side property line cannot exceed 6 feet except for screen extensions (see below).
- Fences within the front yard setback cannot exceed 3 feet.
- Landscaping planted to form a hedge, known as landscape screening, is also held to these height requirements.
- Fences up to 6 feet in height do not require a building permit, but do require Planning Department clearance. Please note: height is measured from approved finished grade.

Screen Extension Exception

- Screen extensions are allowed on top of a 6 foot tall fence or wall, provided total height does not exceed 8 feet, the screen is a design that is a minimum of 35% open (i.e. lattice), and written consent of the adjoining neighbor is provided.
- Screen extensions are not allowed within the front yard setback.
- An approved building permit is required prior to construction.

When is a Building Permit Required?

- Fences that are over 6 feet tall
- Masonry walls that are over 4 feet tall

My property borders a Town park or other public property. Will the Town pay for my fence?

- The Town can contribute up to 50% of the lowest bid. Three bids are required, and other special rules apply. Please call Town Hall for more information.
